What is DADA?

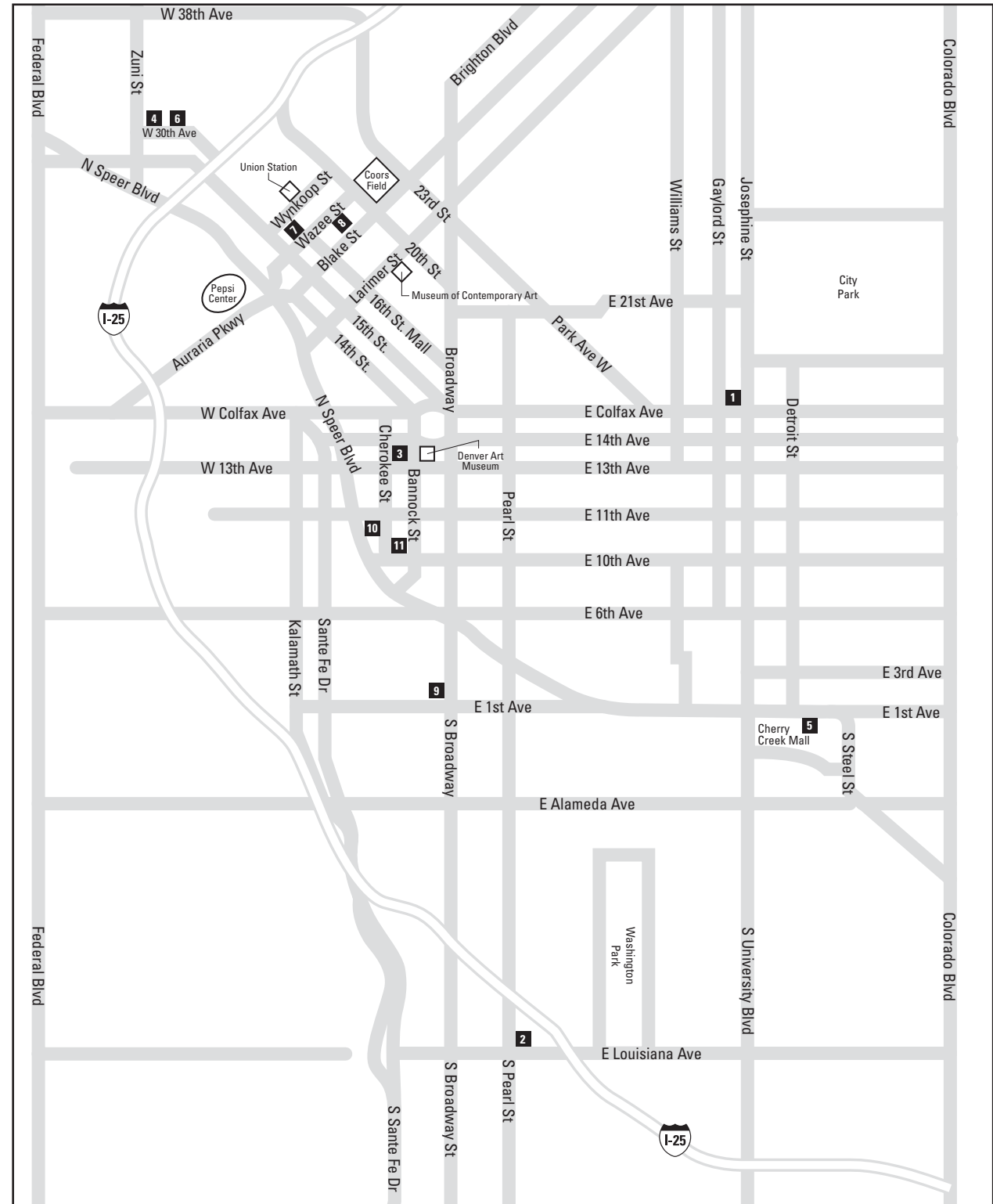
